## BRIEFING: CRIME; RABBI IS GUILTY

A Monmouth County jury convicted Rabbi Fred J. Neulander of murder and conspiracy on Wednesday in the death of his wife, Carol, in 1994. Rabbi Neulander, 61, had been indicted for arranging for two hit men to kill his wife, then 52, at their home in Cherry Hill so as to continue an affair with a Philadelphia radio personality, Elaine Soncini. The rabbi's first trial, last year in Camden, ended in a hung jury. Robert Strauss
