



## Ex-Pastor of San Jose's Largest Church Is Convicted of Molesting Young Boys

A former pastor of San Jose's largest church was convicted yesterday of 15 counts of child molestation.

A jury deliberated a day and a half before deciding that David Brimmer, 40, had engaged young boys in sexual activity while he was a pastor at the 6,000-member Jubilee Christian Center.

The molestations took place over several years, beginning in 1989 and ending in 1993. Several of the boys, then ages 11 to 16, testified in Santa Clara County Superior Court that Brimmer had engaged them in sexual activity during sleep-overs at his home in Milpitas.

Brimmer maintained throughout his trial that the accusations against him were false. He faces a maximum of 20 years and eight months in prison when he is sentenced March 7.

Pablo Boas, 30, a former youth minister at the church and some- time roommate of Brimmer's, pleaded guilty to eight felony counts of child molestation before he was to go on trial with Brimmer.
