Terrance Lamont King, 34, was convicted by a jury Thursday of statutory rape of a child. The pastor of a small church in Hawkinsville, King was sentenced to 30 years in prison. The news release from the Houston County District Attorney's Office.

In November 2012, when the victim was 15, King picked her up before school at a hotel in Perry. The victim told her mother what happened after her mother, saw an inappropriate chat between the two on Facebook.

The victim and her family were lifelong members of the church, the news release stated.
